**Remember, saving energy prevents pollution.** You can reduce the amount of energy your refrigerator or freezer uses, with the following steps:

- Position your refrigerator away from a heat source such as an oven, a dishwasher, or direct sunlight from a window.
- To allow air to circulate around the condenser coils leave a space between the wall or cabinets and the refrigerator or freezer and keep coils clean.
- · Make sure the door seals are airtight.
- Keep your refrigerator between 35° and 38° degrees Fahrenheit and your freezer at 0° degrees Fahrenheit.
- Minimize the amount of time the refrigerator door is open.
- · Recycle older or second refrigerators.
